GENERAL COURSE OUTLINE

Class Piano Intermediate reinforces what students have learned in Class Piano I course such as reading, theory, technique, and general musicianship through more advanced repertoires. This course will help the students improve not only performance capacity but also musicality.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. Reinforcement of reading music on the intermediate level of repertoires
- 2. Continue to learn scales, arpeggios, and cadences in additional major and minor keys.
- 3. Introduce harmonization of melodies and improvisations.
- 4. Achieve in-class performance with musicality, confident self-control, and memorization.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

- 1. Sightread intermediate-level repertoires by understanding more complicated rhythmic/melodic patterns and articulations.
- 2. Play major and minor technique routines in various keys and comfortably apply them with comfortable physical motions.
- 3. Create various accompaniment styles and have a deeper knowledge of music theory to harmonize melodies.
- 4. Perform intermediate-level piano repertoires in various styles with confidence in a live performance setting.

METHODS FOR ASSESSING EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The expected learning outcomes will be assessed through the:

In-class performances, a public recital, quizzes, various musical activities, and exams.

GRADES CALCULATED

- 1. Class Preparation (20%): Students are expected to diligently practice and accomplish their assigned duties for each class.
- 2. Midterm (15%): Students should prepare and present their learning progress for technique routines and one repertoire.
- **3. Piano Proficiency Exam (25%):** Students will learn Major key technique routines from Group I and II.

	1 Repertoire Sight-reading: should include a scale passage and chords

- 4. Final Recital Performance (25%): Students will perform one repertoire by memory and submit a recording. The final recital will be <u>Wednesday</u>, May 7, 2025, at 1 PM.
- 5. Class Attendance (15%): Students are expected to attend every class in person.
