SPC Program Admission Requirements

The number of students admitted to the program is limited, therefore all prospective candidates who wish to be admitted should contact the Associate Degree Nursing program and request an admissions application packet. Applicants must submit a copy of their high school transcript or GED scores, an official copy of all college transcripts, and:

1. Complete the requirements for admission to SPC. **Admission to the college does not guarantee admission to the Associate Degree Nursing program.**
2. Score satisfactorily on entrance examinations administered by the Testing Center.
3. Admission to the program is determined by the Associate Degree Nursing Program Admission/ Academic Standards Committee. Applicants will be notified by letter of the committee's action. Due to limited class numbers, some applicants who meet all the admission requirements may not be accepted. Students must apply each time they wish to be considered.
4. All students applying to the ADN program must be TSI compliant. Students who have repeated any science course or combination of science courses 3 times without passing, are not eligible for admission to the ADN program.
5. All students applying to the ADN program (generic & advanced placement) will undergo a criminal background check required by the Texas Board of Nursing.
6. All prerequisite and corequisite non-nursing courses must have a grade of C or better.

SPC RN to TTU BSN

SPC has an articulation agreement with the TTUHSC School of Nursing. A student must pass the NCLEX exam or they will be provisionally enrolled. To view the program, visit [RN to BSN | Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center \(ttuhsc.edu\)](https://www.ttuhschoolofnursing.edu/rn-to-bsn)

SPC American History Core Component – 060 Options

Additional options are available to complete the American History Core. *Instead of HIST1301, students can take HIST2327 – Mexican American History I, HIST2381 – African American History I, or *HIST2301 – Texas History. For HIST1302, students can take HIST2328 – Mexican American History II, HIST2382 – African American History II, or *HIST2301 – Texas History.* Texas History can be used one time to fulfill three of the six hours required.

TSI-Compliance

Students who are not TSI-compliant in reading or English are advised to take the INRW0300/ENGL1301 corequisite. Successful completion will grant TSI-compliance in these areas and college-credit for ENGL1301. ENGL1302 requires a 'C' or better in the corequisite or approval by the English Chairperson.

Students who are not TSI-compliant in math are advised to take the MATH0314/MATH1314 corequisite. Successful completion will grant TSI-compliance in math and college-credit for MATH1314.

Applicable Transfer Credit Hours

Evaluation of course credit earned at other institutions by the TTU Transfer Evaluation Office does not decree approval of the credit for use toward degree requirements. Only the academic dean of the college offering the degree-granting major a student chooses has authority for determining which courses will be applied toward any specific program. The only exception to this rule is that no transferred course completed with a grade below C- may be applied to fulfill course requirements in majors, minors, or concentrations. Applicants must submit official transcripts to the School of Nursing Office of Admissions. **Only grades with a grade of C- or above can be used to fulfill Texas Core Curriculum and the prerequisite requirements for the RN to BSN program**

Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center Requirements

TTUHSC School of Nursing's RN to BSN program, students must be Texas Core complete, have their Associate's Degree in Nursing, valid RN license, and have all prerequisite courses completed prior to the start of the first semester.
